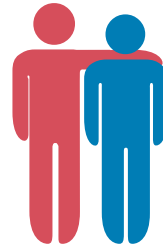
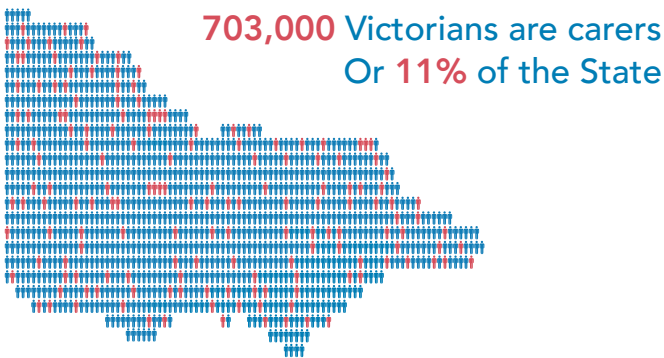

There are **2.65 million** carers in Australia - **1 in 10** Australians

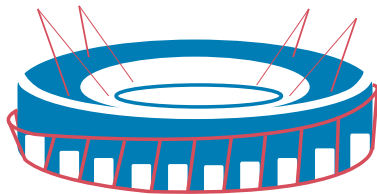
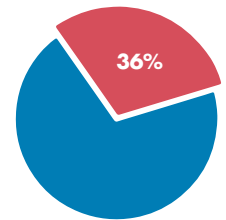


221,300 Victorian primary carers provide the most assistance to another person

11% of Australians in the workforce are carers



36% of Australia's primary carers have been caring for more than a decade



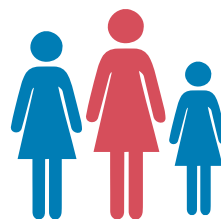
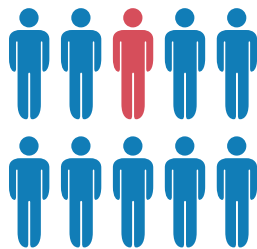
647,000 Australian carers are aged over **65** - more than **6 times** the capacity of the MCG

The cost of replacing unpaid care is estimated at **\$77.9 billion** annually



Equal to over **1.0 million** nurses' annual salaries

1 in 10 carers are **under 25**, with **235,300** young carers Australia-wide



70% of Victorian primary carers are female with **400,500** women and girls having caring responsibilities
