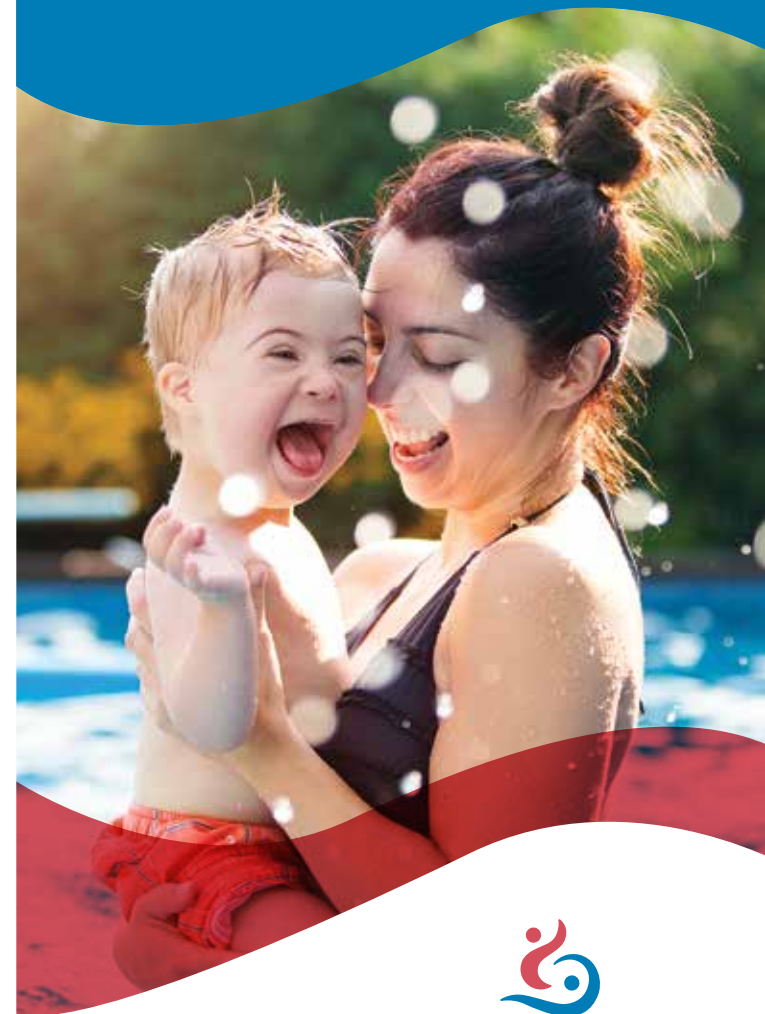

Carers Victoria is the peak body representing unpaid carers in Victoria. Our mission is to ensure all unpaid carers are recognised, valued and supported.

As the only statewide organisation that focuses on the needs of unpaid carers, we take pride in assisting carers across Victoria and championing the voice of all unpaid carers - regardless of the nature of their caring role.

We are an expert source of information about unpaid carers. We produce data, reports, and other materials to build understanding of the critical role that unpaid carers play across Victoria and advocate for changes to systems, services and supports.

## What we do

Carers Victoria works with government, other statewide organisations, service providers, and private organisations to improve supports for carers and ensure their voices are heard.

An expert source of information and assistance for all Victorian carers, Carers Victoria operates a free Carer Advisory Service (1800 514 845) and maintains up-to-date information and advice for carers via regular newsletters and our website.

Connecting carers with each other is a critical part of what we do, through a statewide program of events, education workshops and other programs. For carers living in Melbourne's West, we provide access to a range of local, government-funded support services. Additionally, we deliver education workshops to carer support group leaders and service providers across the state.
