ABOUT

More than 62,400 young people in Victoria are believed to have significant care responsibilities.

They may support their mother, father, sister, brother or grandparent at home who have a disability, chronic illness, experience mental ill health or addiction or with aging care needs.

Many are at risk of dropping out of school or have difficulty maintaining social networks and participating in activities with their peers.

Carers Victoria's **Young Carer Scholarship Program** gives young carers attending secondary school the opportunity to be acknowledged for their contributions to their family and the community. It offers them the opportunities to:

- participate in school or community-based activities that enhance their skills, educational achievement and abilities,
- help them to participate more fully in their community.

Scholarships of up to \$500 are awarded to successful applicants and made possible by The Collie Foundation.



WHO CAN APPLY

Young Carer Scholarships are open to secondary school students who live or go to school in Victoria and provide care and support to a family member with an illness or disability.

Please note the number of scholarships awarded is dependent on the amount of funding available.

Those who receive a 2025 Carers Australia Young Carer Bursary will not be eligible.

Secondary school students in Victoria who give care and support to a family member with a disability, mental illness, chronic health issue or an older person with care needs. Please note all applicants must have the consent of a parent or guardian before submitting.



YOUNG CARER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES 2025

More than 62,400 young people in Victoria are believed to have significant care responsibilities. They may be supporting a mother, father, sister, brother, or grandparent who has a disability, mental illness, chronic health issue or an older person with care needs.

WHO CAN APPLY?
Applications are open to secondary school students in Victoria who give care and support to a family member with a disability, mental illness, chronic health issue or an older person with care needs. The scholarship should contribute to helping students to develop their skills, participate in activities and assist with educational learning.

Applications will be accepted from young people with caring responsibilities, providing they have the knowledge and consent of a parent or guardian.

Applications will also be accepted from parents, teachers, friends or service providers on a young person's behalf and with their input.

WHAT CAN BE APPLIED FOR?
Scholarships are up to \$500 and can be awarded for:
• school or community based classes/activities, such as camps or excursions
• sporting club participation fees
• tutoring
• skills-based activities and lessons such as dance, music, fitness or driving
• club memberships
• direct educational expenses such as compulsory fees, books, uniforms, and fares

Caring can be a very positive experience; helping a young person to develop skills and build strong relationships. But it can also have some negative effects on a young person's health and wellbeing. Many young carers are at risk of dropping out of school, or have difficulty maintaining social networks and participating in activities with their peers.

PRIORITY
Over the last 17 years the Young Carer Scholarship Program has provided support to over 2,300 young carers attending secondary school in Victoria. The scholarships give young carers the opportunity to participate in school or community based activities that enhance their skills, educational achievement and abilities, or that help them to participate more fully in their community. Highest priority will be given to applications from young people who are:
• living in rural and regional areas.
• from First Nations or culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.

The following applications will be accepted but given a lower priority:
• previous scholarship recipients.

When does the application process open?

Application opens Monday 3 March 2025.

When does the application process close?

Application closes Sunday 13 April 2025.

When do successful applicants find out?

Notification of successful applicants and payment will be made by Friday 30 May 2025.

Who is funding the scholarship?

The Young Carer Scholarship program is administered by Carers Victoria and funded by the generosity of the Collier Foundation.

Can past Young Carer Scholarship recipients apply in 2025?

Yes, so long as they meet the eligibility criteria as found on page three.
